Intro

The PDF "honkskillet.pdf" was imported and starts on page 2. It has an invisible Heading that only shows in the TOC.

On the 1st page of the imported PDF a visible Heading and some Chord Diagrams were inserted

On the 2nd page also a visible Heading was created and some notes were covered with a white rectangle. On top of that a simple table is shown.

The 3rd page was removed. But I left a visible Heading.

This content can be edited in LibreOffice. The content of the imported PDF is independent from that and can be updated on its own (by replacing/overwriting the PDF in the source directory)

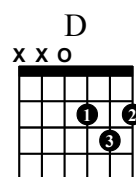
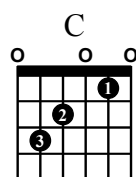
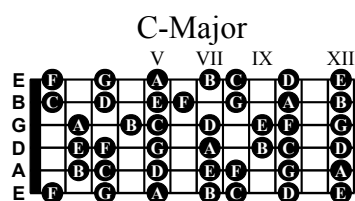
In addition to what is suggested in the post, since MuseScore exports well to PDF, but does not allow a good management of the text, you can take advantage of the potential of a software such as PdfSam to merge various documents. It will then be possible to number the pages, cut or merge them. Sure it will require some work but it could give good results.

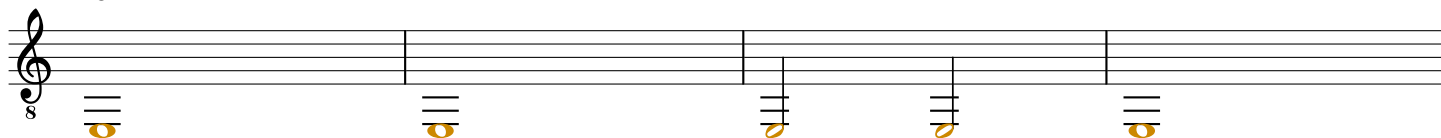

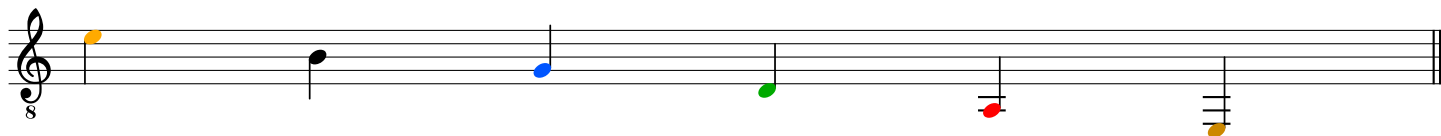
