

Turn playback on/off

The following methods enable you to turn on/off playback of symbols for all or part of the score (Note: [Audio](#) and [MIDI export](#) is also affected).

For all symbols

To turn playback on/off for *all* chord symbols and Nashville numbers in the score:

1. Select a chord symbol or Nashville number
2. In the "Chord Symbol" section of the [Inspector](#) check/uncheck the "Play" box.
3. Click on the associated "Set as style" button (to the right of that box, you may need to scroll a bit)
