Detailed description: This is a guitar tablature for the song 'Twelve Days of Christmas'. It is arranged for acoustic guitar by Lance Austin. The piece is in 3/4 time and uses a capo. The tablature is divided into systems, each starting with a measure number (7, 13, 19, 25, 31, 37). Above the first system, a capo is indicated at position 3. Above the system starting at measure 19, a capo is indicated at position 4. Above the system starting at measure 37, a capo is indicated at position 5, and a '3' is written above the staff, likely indicating a triplet.
