

## Tuplet (from the MuseScore Handbook svn 2690)

To enter a triplet in Note Entry mode using keyboard shortcuts:

1. Press *N* to begin note entry mode
2. Make sure the note entry marker is in the place that you want to start the triplet (use the right and left arrow keys if necessary)
3. Select the length of the whole triplet (5 for a crochet/quarter note &c.)
4. Press *Ctrl-3*
5. Enter the notes or rests that make up the triplet. The notes will be given the default length (displayed as half the triplet length — a crochet/quarter note triplet will, by default, have quavers/eighth notes in it). If one of the notes is to have a different length, select the note length before entering it.

For instance, entering 5, *Ctrl-3*, *C E G* will give

enter 5, *Ctrl-3*, 5, *F*, 4, *C*
