This piece is the slow movement of Mozart's *Eine kleine Nachtmusik* (A Little Night Music), probably his most popular and best loved instrumental work. He composed it in the summer of 1787, while working on his opera *Don Giovanni*. Written for string quartet and double bass, it belongs to a type of entertainment music called *notturno* (nocturne), intended for performance at night.

The vocal 'romance' genre is here imitated in a slow movement of simple, lyrical character. It is in ABA song form, but only the A section is given here. Quaver pairs (bb. 3, 6 and 14–15) might be played (the original string version has ). The only exception is the quaver pair at the beginning of b. 7, which should be played as written.
